Create a trivia quiz game with questions about evolution, famous scientists (like Charles Darwin), and different species.

Evolution: Use different household items (e.g., tweezers, spoons, chopsticks) to simulate different bird beak types and test which is best for picking up various foods (e.g., seeds, pasta, rice).

Create fact cards for each country in North America, including capital cities, flags, population, landmarks, and interesting facts.
